Bumper Removal:


- 1. Open the rear tailgate or barn doors and remove the four fixings from the rear panel.
- 2. Remove the lower fixing from the wheel arch lining and the tip screw from each side.
- 3. Remove the two fixings from the lower bumper edge.
- 4. Unplug the wiring loom from the nearside, then pull the bumper out sideways and rearwards to remove.
- 5. Cut the bumper as shown in Figure 1 for all bumpers & Figure 2 for Active models with the additional exterior panel.
- **6.** Remove the rear impact beam, six fixings.
- 7. If the vehicle has the three-piece plastic inner bumper support remove the two outer sections by drilling out the rivets and detaching them as shown in Figures 3 & 4. Models with a one-piece plastic inner bumper support, drill out the rivets and cut the ends off using Figures 3 & 4 as a guide.

Ad-Blue Models Only:

Carefully lower the Ad-Blue tank from the nearside chassis rail via the four fixings show in Figure 5 to gain access to the vertical mounting point for item B1.
Note: It may be necessary to temporarily release the filling pipes and wiring looms to enable the tank to be lowered. Always ensure the tank is supported.

Towbar Installation:

- 1. Loosely fix item A to the rear panel using items G with items J.
- 2. Loosely fix items B1 & B2 inside each chassis rail using items H with items L.
- 3. Loosely fix items **B1 & B2** to item **A** using items **H** with items **K**.
- **1.** Fully tighten all the fixings ensuring the Towbar is rigid, square and secure.
- **5.** Refit the bumper and reconnect the wiring loom.
- 6. Loosely fix item C to item A to the correct position shown in Figure 6 using items E with items K and item F with items K ensuring item T1 is fitted at the lower mounting point.
- 7. Loosely fix the desired ball bracket and wiring (Not supplied in this kit) to item C using item D.
- 8. Fully tighten the remaining fixings ensuring item C is rigid, square and secure.



Notes:

- 1. Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturer's trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
- 2. We recommend the use of PRO-TOW Couplings with all our products.
