

Tow-Trust Towbars



Bumper Removal:

- 1. Open the tailgate and unclip the upper bumper trim to reveal four fixings and remove.
- On models with sidewards opening door temporarily remove the door stay. 2.
- 3. Remove the one fixing/two on later models from the upper bumper edge.
- 4. Remove the eight fixings on the lower bumper edge.
- 5. Remove the five fixings from the wheel arch each side.
- 6. Pull the bumper out sideways then rearwards to remove carefully unplugging the two wiring connectors on the nearside and one on the offside where applicable.
- 7. Cut the bumper as shown below.

Towbar Installation:

- 1. Loosely attach item A to the underside of the chassis using items F with items G.
- Loosely attach item **B** to the rear face of the chassis using items **F** with items **G**. (Only hand tightened to enable parts to be aligned). 2.
- 3. Temporarily insert items E to ensure items A and B are lined up correctly then remove item B.
- 4. Fully tighten the fixings for item **A**.
- 5. Loosely attach item **B** to the rear face of the chassis using items **F** with items **G**.
- Loosely attach item C to items A and B using items E with items H. 6.
- 7. Fully tighten all fixings ensuring the towbar is rigid, square, and secure.
- 8. Refit the rear bumper.
- 9. Using item **D** fix your desired ball bracket and socket plate to item **C** and fully tighten.



- 1. For Torque settings see general notes overleaf.
- 2. Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturer's trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
